



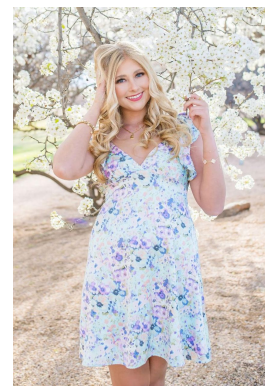
2024 Scholarships
