About a month ago, Sonny and his wife lost their 25-year-old daughter in a car accident. This crushing weight only adds to the ongoing sorrow and stress of caring for their bed-bound 27-year-old son, who suffered a traumatic brain injury in a car crash 7 years ago. Sonny's job as a shuttle driver is the only income for the family, and they need help paying for their daughter's funeral. We wrote a check to help cover those costs. Words cannot express our sympathy, Sonny. We hope this helps, during your time of grief. We are with you.

is the head coach of Cibola High School's Boys' Soccer Team. This loving husband and father of three was recently in an accident that damaged his spinal cord.
