



Honoring our First Responders

Last month, four members of our law enforcement community in Albuquerque were shot while responding to a robbery call. The officers arrived quickly at the scene, where two suspects opened fire and kept shooting until one suspect was shot down and the other ran, leaving four officers wounded, one in critical condition with a wound in his neck, just above his protective vest. Another officer was shot in the chest, but his protective vest took most of the damage. Another officer was shot in the arm and the other was hit in the eye by shrapnel.

While gunfire is a known hazard of policework, no one is fully prepared for or protected from being fired upon. And when such a tragedy does happen, everyone needs time to heal from these incredible wounds which are not only physical, but also mental and emotional.

In addition to our sincere gratitude and support for their protection, Los Ojos de la Familia also provided each of these good gentlemen a check from our First Responders Initiative, to help cover some off their medical and living expenses while they are on the mend.
