are a couple with three children, who have fallen behind on their bills, with an income less than their means, as it has been difficult finding a job that pays well enough to bring income, taking into account the cost of daycare for the children. We helped them with some of their rent.

is a woman who, just a couple weeks ago, lost her husband in a tragic home accident. Now a single mother of four, she has been forced out of her home while the electric company fixes the problem. With no family in the area, all they have are the clothes on their backs. We gave them a Walmart Gift Card to help with household
